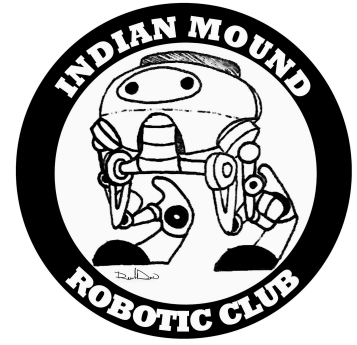

Last season, every team qualified for the State tournament. It is my goal that every team qualifies this year. We have a lot of work to prepare for our last tournament on February 10 in Appleton, WI.

I aim to finish the season with a balance of nearly \$2000 so the team can sign up for tournaments and buy supplies before the season starts. Companies can use the Classmunity site (it gives a receipt for tax purposes for all donations) or send a check, and the district will then mail a receipt.

Last year's fundraiser allowed the team to donate 1000 dollars to help start the new high school robotics club.

Budget at the start of the season: \$2400

Spent as of January 21: \$2540

- Parts: \$1100
 - Pitching In, game field kits,
 - VEX parts, cables, specialty parts...
- Tournament fees paid to date: \$1440
 - Registration for five teams: \$825
 - Tournament registration is 50-55 dollars per team for two tournaments, a total \$600
 - Our DeForest tournament registration was **free** since we co-hosted
State Tournament to be determined
 - **One hundred seventy-five per team, two to five teams? \$350 to \$700**

Revenue: \$1200

- Student Fees: \$1200

Current Robotics Club Balance: \$1060

Fundraising Goal: \$2500
